ODOT to Conduct Public Meeting for I-475 and US 23 Strategic Plan

Bowling Green: Ohio Department of Transportation Acting Deputy Director Mike Ligibel today announced a public meeting concerning the I-475 and US 23 transportation corridor in Lucas and Wood Counties.
